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Module Descriptions

MY PROFILE: The MY PROFILE module is available to all users. It allows users to manage their personal profile information and access agency-authorized features and functions.

USERS & SETTINGS: The USERS & SETTINGS module is available to users with manager-level credentials. Authorized users can manage user accounts, update agency-approved profile information, and administer global system settings.

INVENTORY: The INVENTORY module can operate as a standalone solution for agencies that need to track inventory items, quantities, and storage locations without managing item issuance. It supports an unlimited number of inventory items and locations.

ARMORY: The ARMORY module manages the assignment and lifecycle of firearms, including department-issued, communal, less-lethal, loaner, privately owned, and government-loaned firearms. It also supports firearms acquired through programs such as the U.S. Department of Defense 1033 Program. The module maintains comprehensive maintenance, inspection, and service records for all tracked firearms.

EQUIPMENT: The EQUIPMENT module tracks the issuance, return, and management of department-owned, communal, and government-loaned equipment, including assets acquired through programs such as the U.S. Department of Defense 1033 Program. It also manages equipment maintenance and issuance of vouchers, uniforms, duty gear, supplies, replacement parts, and accessories.

TRAINING: The TRAINING module manages in-service training, external training requests, approvals, and documentation. It includes a fully integrated Learning Management System (LMS) that supports online courses, testing, SCORM-compliant content, and other training formats. The module also tracks employee training history, certifications, qualifications, and continuing education records.

SHOOTING RANGE: The SHOOTING RANGE module manages firearm qualifications, courses of fire, and range operations. It includes a native iOS application for recording qualification scores and capturing target photographs when desired. The module also provides a comprehensive scheduling system that allows both internal and external agencies to reserve range facilities.

LOCKERS: The LOCKERS module tracks the check-out and check-in of communal firearms and equipment. It includes automated curfew monitoring and configurable notifications delivered by email, text message (SMS), or both.

KIOSK: The KIOSK module provides a self-service solution for checking communal firearms and equipment in and out. It can also be configured as a training registration kiosk, allowing personnel to quickly register for scheduled training events.
